Speaker guidelines

All presentations are to be submitted to the Secretary on Monday May 20 for uploading on the conference computer and verification of function of any animations or videos. If the speakers presentation is via zoom, control of the slides will be handed over to the speaker.

Please arrive 10 minutes early for your session, or be prepared for the zoom teleconference 10 mins prior.

Please refrain from using the very bottom of the slides as attendees at the back of the room have difficulty seeing the lower parts of the slides.

Please check that your color choice projects well and can be read from a distance.

Please keep your slides concise with words to a minimum so that they are easily read from a distance. A picture is often worth a thousand words.

Please practice the delivery of your presentation, using simple sentences and avoiding jargon.

Guest speakers will be recorded for pod casts.

Speakers will be notified of 5 minutes remaining in their allocated time.

Ten minutes will be allocated at the end of the presentation for questions. This time will be revoked if the speaker goes over time.

Speakers will be kept to their allocated time slots to ensure fairness to all speakers.

Please stop when signaled by the moderator to do so.

Abstract research/case presentation guidelines

Presenters will be notified of 2 minutes remaining of their allotted speaking time.

Please stop when signaled by the moderator to do so.
